
1-Open Cabinet box and remove boxed door. Do not remove boxed door from it's carton until installation of door is required.


When recessing electric cabinet in wall, cabinet may not be able to be fully recessed in wall opening. Check all local electric and building codes for restrictions concerning proper clearance between electric wire, cabinet, and wall.

NOTE:

Installation of electric cabinets shall be performed by a qualified licensed electrician.

NOTE: Grounding Instruction:

This product must be connected to a grounded metal, permanent wiring system, or an equipment-grounding conductor must be run with the circuit conductors and connected to the equipment-grounding terminal or lead on the cabinet.



"E" Option-make the final electrical connection within the Electric Outlet Shelf as supplied pre-wired for the outlets. Be sure to close the access panel in the shelf with the screws provided. If unit is equipped with a door heater, plug into the receptacle on the Electric Outlet Shelf.

Be sure that the rough wiring is positioned correctly behind the opening or surface mount location of the cabinet for the location of the electric connection in the cabinet.

For cabinets with the "E" option-- remove the two screws on the front of the outlet shelf and attach a suitable cable clamp in the back of the panel.

The rough wire for this cabinet should extend through the cabinet at least 8" so that connections can be made.

The cabinet combination shown as typical in this manual indicates the location for electrical connections.

Connection locations for other combinations of cabinets will vary. Up to 4 cabinets can be wired to one circuit.

Activate the door heater from switch on outlet shelf. Within 3 minutes the center portion of the door will get warm. The center area of the mirror comprising approximatley 2 square feet will provide fog free viewing. If the de-fogger does not function check wiring to the outlet shelf. DO NOT ATTEMPT TO REPAIR THE DOOR. Their are no field servicable parts. Contact the factory or your dealer.


TOOLS REQUIRED

Locate Medicine Cabinet at correct height. Make sure their is at least 1" of clearance above any obstructions as shown below.



Formula for determining Rough Opening

Cabinet Width Minus 3/4"

For Two or more Cabinets, Cabinet Width Minus 3/4" Plus Second Cabinet Width Example (15 " wide


Example (15 " wide Cabinet Plus one 19" Wide Cabinet = 15" - 3/4" = 14 1/4" + 19" = 33 1/4"




RECESS MEDICINE CABINET INSTALLATION Follow steps 1,2,3


Determine correct Rough Opening using Formula Provided.Make sure Opening is **PLUMB** and **LEVEL**.

Place Cabinet Box into Rough Opening.Make sure cabinet flange covers rough opening evenly all around.Shim as needed.





Insert (4) # 10 x 1 1/2" Wood screws Provided into four locations provided for recessed installation as shown. Be careful not to overtighten .Make sure Cabinet is centered in Rough Opening.





MEDICINE CABINET INSTALLATION SURFACE MOUNT

Follow steps 5,6,7,8,


Determine correct height and draw a level horizontal line as shown in Sketch 5.







Place bottom of wall bracket on horizontal line and at correct position Left to Right and mark hole location as shown in Sketch 7.





Drill 8 mm holes for wall anchors provided. Insert wall anchors and mount wall bracket as shown in Sketch 8 & 9.



Place Cabinet onto Wall bracket as shown in Sketch's 12 &13. Mark hole locations of Z clips. Remove Cabinet and drill 8mm holes for Z Clips. Insert wall anchors, remount Cabinet, and attach with screws provided as shown in Sketch 14.









Cabinet Connector Installation




Connect Two or more cabinets together using Cabinet Connectors Part # 11 & 10-32 x 1/2" machine screws Part # 12 as Shown in Sketch 15.







If connecting more than Two (2) cabinets together and you are recessing them, it is recommended that at approxamitly the center of the combined cabinets that you drill a # 7 hole in the inside top of cabinet and place a # 10 wood screw part # 9 as shown in sketchs 16 & 17.




Side Kit Installation

Using 10-32 x 1/2" Machine screws attach Side Kit Mounting Bracket as shown. Clean back of side kit mirror with alchole pad then place foam pads to mirror as shown. Peel tape off of Brackets and place Mirrored Side kit as shown. Repeat process for opposite side.





Remove Cover Cap for Hinge Adjustment. Replace Caps when adjustment is completed.



After door and cabinet are installed, Peel Release from Name Plate & Door and Place Name Plates as shown in Sketch 19 & 20
